- Provide education and training to workers to establish and maintain competency.
- Provide effective rehabilitation support and services to workers in the event of a work-related injury or ill-health.

Workers must take reasonable care for their own safety and health, avoiding behaviour that might harm the safety or health of others. All workers have the right to refuse work if they have reasonable grounds to believe there is an immediate risk of serious injury or harm to themselves or others in the workplace.
